Fee for joining the Society and First year's membership €100

Subsequent annual subscription €75

Calf registrations costs;

Heifer Calves €45 pedigree cert issued when animal is Scored by ICBF.

Bull Calves €10 and a pedigree certificate if needed will be an extra €50. All bull calves must have a DNA code before a pedigree certificate can be issued.

Animals not scored are entered into Pedigree Class 2 of the herdbook

A first Pedigree Certificate will only be issued to the breeder of the animal not to any subsequent owner.

Imported registrations €60

Registration and Pedigree Cert on change of ownership €15

Embryo registrations €3 each

Refunds of €40 are payable on heifers that haven't bred or birthed a calf and are proved to be infertile.

All pedigree animals must be registered at birth.

All animals are registered through the ICBF either with the white book as supplied by ICBF or through the AIMS agfood.ie website. To distinguish between pedigree and commercial calves just name the calf and it will be added to the pedigree database.

Not all purebred calves are named as the breeder may not consider them to be good enough and so they will not be automatically added to the Pedigree Register but if they are in the ICBF database they can be added later.

. All animals must be registered within the 28 day period of birth as dictated by the Dept. of Agriculture. Penalty of €1 a day is payable for animals registered after 60 days and a DNA sample may be required
